FWGA 2026 Spring Meeting Minutes

New Business –

- Adopting PlayGolfLex AM Tour for lost balls – Kathy McArdle made a motion, seconded by Diane Abbott that we would have an option to either go back and

take stroke and distance or take a 2 stroke penalty and move ball to fairway, motion passed.

- Stroke and Distance on green – when ball is on the green, putted and goes into a bunker you can take stroke and distance. Take a 1 stroke penalty and replay from same spot.
- Lakeside, white tees vs. gold tees. LS has been re-rated and is 930 yds. longer. We will have the option to either play white tees or gold tees.
- Pace of play – keep up with group ahead of you, limit use of range finders, and let group behind you play through if you can't keep up.
- Scramble vs. Shamble – discussion to change to shamble instead of scramble on closing day. Evie motioned, seconded by Natalie Britton, to keep as scramble, motion passed.
